Ms. Choi has served as principal cellist of the Juilliard Pre-College Symphony and Pre-College Chamber Orchestra numerous times. Her previous teachers include Uk-Jin Yang, Jerome Carrington and Clara Minhye Kim. Jennifer has performed in many master classes for many cellists, including Irene Sharp. Ms. Choi has attended the Meadowmount School of Music in 2005, and this past summer in 2009 with Hans Jorgen Jensen.
