Ms. Yang Yi is recognized today as a foremost Guzheng master in the world, described by *The New York Times* as “fascinating, surprising and extraordinarily beautiful” and “extraordinarily fantastic, intensive and passionate” by the *West German News*. A winner of the International Chinese Instruments Competition and numerous awards, Yang Yi is a highly acclaimed guzheng virtuoso, distinguished guzheng educator, and lecturer. Yang Yi was a faculty at the prestigious China Conservatory of music, her alma mater. She has performed as a soloist with almost all of the distinguished Chinese Musical Groups before moving to the US in 1991. As a soloist, Yang Yi has toured extensively throughout Asia, Europe and the U.S., and performed in prestigious venues such as the Royal Albert Hall (UK), Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, Radio City Music Hall, Historische Stadthalle Wuppertal (Germany), Anhaltisches Theater Dessau (Germany).

In addition to introducing the traditional repertoire to the Western audiences, Yang Yi has successfully advanced the art of tradition with inspired new compositions. She has world premiered many new composition works by today’s most renowned composers. She collaborated with distinguished groups such as the Kronos Quartet, Four Nation Ensemble, and has appeared at countless festivals. She gave unique and educational solo / lecture concerts at venues such as The Cooper Union, Hunter College, University of Massachusetts, The Settlement Music School, Rutgers University, Yale, Princeton University, and The Julliard School of Music.

Her musical recordings can be found on many publicly released CDs; movies, and TV series, and she has been profiled in many music and documentary programs on radio and TV stations, such as the BBC, China National Broadcasting Radio Station, Voice of America, and dozens of regional radio stations throughout China.
